



The Cruising Nationals Motor Vehicle Events Rules and Scrutineering Form

Drag Racing Rules

- Both Drag Racing and Dirt Drag Racing will be conducted over an 1/8th mile track. All vehicles must slow down after the 1/8th mile run is completed.
- Runs will be two car runs. There will be a maximum of two cars per drag race on the drag racing track at any given time throughout the drag racing events.
- All cars and motorcycles must comply with the Scrutineering Checklist Requirements below.

Burnout Competition Rules

- No static burnouts to be completed throughout the burnout competition.
- All competitors in the burnout competition get a maximum ONE minute to do their burnout. Anyone going over the one minute mark will be disqualified from completing any more burnouts throughout the event
 - All burnouts are conducted in a 40 metre in diameter circle. All burnouts must be completed inside the circle.
- All burnout competition entrants must abide and comply with the Scrutineering Checklist Requirements below.

Car and Bike Scrutineering Checklist - Requirements

- No major oil leaks
- Radiator overflow bottle
- Secure battery
- No petrol leaks
- No loose objects in vehicle
- x2 Return springs on carburettor

- Fully functioning seat belts

Driver and Passenger - Requirements

- Structurally sound helmets
- Long sleeve shirts & pants
- Proper foot wear (No thongs and Sandals)
- Leather clothing and protection for motorcyclists

Officials will perform scrutineering on the day, so please make sure your vehicle passes all of these checks before entering any drag racing events and the burnout competition to avoid disappointment.
